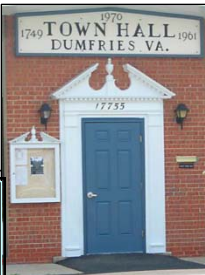

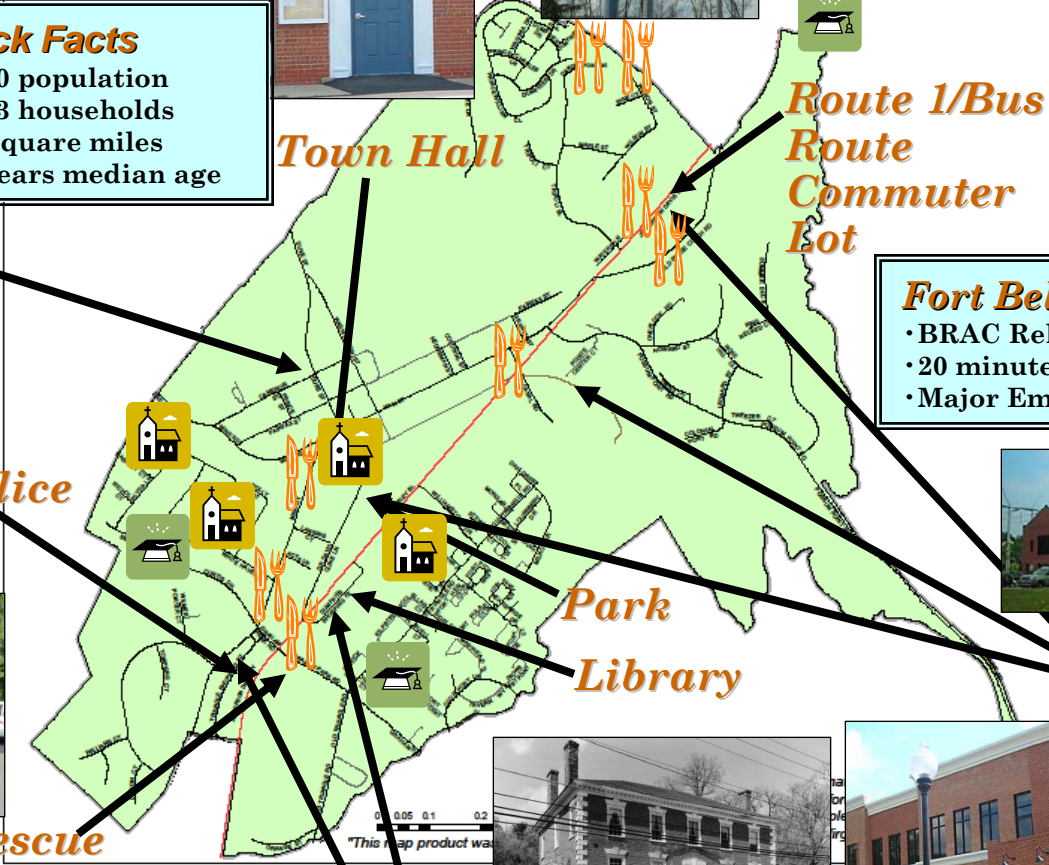

## Town of Dumfries

Established in 1749 as the Quantico Creek Harbor, Dumfries remains Virginia oldest continuously chartered Town. In 1759, the County Court house was moved to Dumfries. As a bustling commerce center, the colonial Town entertained locals such as George Washington and George Mason who shipped their tobacco crop from its port. Here, in the Town, these locals debated democratic values that continue in our way of life.

By the 1800's, the Town focused toward the railroad industry. In 1917, the Quantico Marine Base was established nearby. At the same time, Route 1, or Main Street, became a major north south connector. Since 1968, I-95 provides high speed access to the Town. Indeed, Dumfries can be accessed by over 55% of the Nation's population in an 8 hour drive.

Today, the Town's proud past remains with its people, its culture, its ancient roads and in its buildings. Today, the Town retains its colonial values of freedom while forging into a new century.
